


# City of Allentown Environmental Justice Map

Note: An Environmental Justice Area is an area of a community disproportionately affected by environmental pollution and other hazards that can lead to negative health effects, exposure, or environmental degradation. Scores are based on level of environmental exposures and effects (Pollution Burden) and sensitive population and socioeconomic characteristics (Population Characteristics). Block groups at or above the 80th percentile threshold qualify as Environmental Justice Areas.
