


Park Improvement Opportunities - Andre Reed Park



9.8 Acre Community Park located in the East Side (E-2):

- Home of the recently reconstructed Irving Pool
- 2 diamond fields
- 1 multiuse field
- 2 basketball courts
- 4 tennis courts (pickleball lines)
- 1 playground, public pool, and restrooms.



Safety/Access



Old paths do not meet ADA standards, need signage/kiosk for more information for the park and usage, bike lanes to the park would provide safety and traffic calming

Recreation Facilities




Parts of the park are new while others are still in need of replacing/fixing (tennis courts, small ball field, paths, etc), provide areas for sitting especially under grove of mature tree canopy, additional programming at the park to include Monday Funday, Adult programming (senior social hours, paint/photography class, etc.) cultural programs

Ecology



Continue to plant more trees for shade, create naturalized planting areas in spaces where lawn does not provide recreational use, stormwater management needed by small field

Park Improvement Opportunities - West Park



Historic 6.5 acre passive recreation park with a bandshell on the West Side (W-7):

- Arboretum setting with diversity of trees and shrubs
- Band shell
- Kiosk
- Restrooms
- Host summer concert series
- West Park Civic Association - partner




Safety/Access

Continue to repair walkways and historic structures as required, add additional programming for all ages (puppet shows, plays, etc.). Consider identifying partners to offer a Performing Arts Camp in the future.

Ecology



Continue to add trees and use more native species for both tree canopy and ground plane plantings
